What can you do to help your child?

- Give support as your child reads more challenging books. Ask questions about what they have read e.g. can they recall the main points, predict story outcomes and infer from clues in the text (see reading on the school's website).
- Encourage reading for pleasure.
- Learn to tell the time on analogue and digital clocks.
- Support your child as they develop a quick recall of times table facts and related division facts.
- Encourage your child to become more independent, responsible and organised.
