Think about:

The prefix in- does change before certain letters:

- Before a root word starting with l, in- becomes il- : illegal, illegible
- Before a root word starting with m or p, in- becomes im-: immature, immortal, impossible, impatient, imperfect
- Before a root word starting with r, in- becomes ir-: irregular, irrelevant, irresponsible
