Words with the Prefix 'im-'
before a Root Word Starting
with 'm' or 'p'

immature	immeasurable
impossible	immortal
imperfect	impatient
immovable	impolite
important	improper

When we add the prefix im- to a root word that already begins with m, the two m's stay together.

This makes the word easier to say and keeps the spelling correct.

For example:

possible → impossible / mature → immature / mobile → immobile

The rule:

If the root word begins with m or p, we use im- instead of in-.
