Maths:

This week in maths, we have completed our unit on ordering fractions and have practised finding common multiples so that fractions with different denominators can be added or subtracted.

TASK: Complete pages 20 – 21 in your CGP Maths Book. Mark your work using the answers in the back of the book. Continue to spend time brushing up on your times tables so that they are really quick and fluent. This is due in on **Tuesday 27th January**.

Spellings:

This week's spellings are all words with the -ie spelling. When practising, ensure that you know what each word means and how to use it in context. The words are:
