Please ensure that your child completes the homework set every week and returns it to school on a **Tuesday**. Reading

Please remember to read with your child **daily** and support them with understanding through comprehension of the text and not just decoding. Please sign and date the reading record each time you hear them read. If you have any comments you wish to write about your child's reading, please do so.

English:

This week in English, we have begun looking at how dialogue is used to engage the reader and move the narrative on.

TASK: Complete pages 64 and 65 in your CGP SPAG book. This is due in on Tuesday 4th March.

Maths:

This week in maths, we have continued working on the order of operations, extending into algebraic expressions and balanced equations.

TASK: Complete pages 42 – 45 in your CGP Maths Book. Mark your work using the answers in the back of the book and the answer sheet. This is due in on Tuesday 4th March.

Spelling:

TASK: Practise spellings that are homophones, such as course/coarse, pair/pear, knit/nit, mist/missed etc ensuring that you know the meanings in context. See how many others you can find to practise. We will test spellings based on these patterns on Monday 3rd March.

Subject of the Week: This week's subject is reading as we lead up to next week's book week and World Book Day.

TASK: Prepare to talk about your favourite book – it can be one you've recently read that had a real impact on you or one that is an old favourite. Think about why you like it and how you'd persuade others that it's a good read. Prepare a short persuasive speech to convince your classmates to read this book. This is due in on Thursday 6th March.
