English:

This week in English, we have continued our unit based on the book Talking History and have practised writing a persuasive radio advertisement. We will be using this book to inspire persuasive speeches.

TASK: Complete pages 43 – 45 in your CGP SPAG Book. This is due in on **Tuesday 28th January.**

Maths:

This week in maths, we have worked on percentages, finding different percentages of numbers and problem solving with percentages.

TASK: Complete pages 28 – 29 in your CGP Maths Book. Mark your work using the answers in the back of the book and the answer sheet. This is due in on **Tuesday 28th January.**

Spellings:

This week we have looked at words with an unstressed vowel.

TASK: Use the words on the list to practise the spellings, making sure that you understand them in context and could use them correctly in a sentence, ready to be tested on **Monday 27th January.**

Subject of the Week: This week the focus is Spanish.

TASK: Choose a place in Spain that you would like to visit. Find out about the place – how would you travel there, can you get there without flying, what would you see when you were there? Present your findings as a persuasive map with notes around it. This is due in on **Tuesday 28th January.**
