### Reading

### English:

This week in English, we have practised using the active and passive voice as well as revising subject and object in a sentence.

**TASK: Complete pages 38 – 41 in your CGP SPAG book. This is due in on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> March.**

### Maths:

This week in maths, we have practised angles on a straight line as well as long division.

**TASK: Complete page 11 in your CGP Maths Book plus the worksheet on our homework page. Mark your work using the answers in the back of the book and the answer sheet. This is due in on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> March.**

### Spelling:

**TASK: Practise spellings that contain the letters 'mit' ensuring that you know the meanings in context (see separate sheet). See how many other related words you can find to practise. We will test spellings based on these patterns on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> March.**

**Subject of the Week: This week's subject is poetry**

**TASK: Based on the National Poetry Day that we will be celebrating on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> March, either – research the poet Neal Zetter and try to learn one of his poems or choose your own favourite poem to learn or write your own poem**
