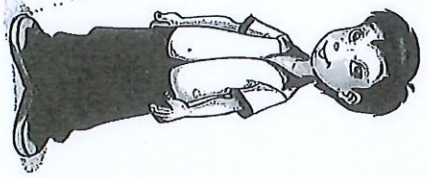
We can learn about different things in **non-fiction** books. They are full of **facts**.

They often catch small animals to eat.
