Reading

Maths:

This week in maths, Year 5 have continued their work on fractions by comparing and ordering fractions.

TASK: Practise the multiplication and division skills you were using recently by completing the worksheet. You can print it out or read it on screen and write the answers in your homework book. This is due in on **Tuesday 4th March.**

Spelling:

TASK: Practise spellings that Mrs Howard set on Class Story. The letter patterns are words with the suffix endings '-ant', '-ance' and '-ancy'. These will be tested on **Tuesday 4th March.**

Subject of the Week: This week's subject is reading as we lead up to next week's book week and World Book Day.

TASK: Prepare to talk about your favourite book – it can be one you've recently read that had a real impact on you or one that is an old favourite. Think about why you like it and how you'd persuade others that it's a good read. Prepare a short persuasive speech to convince your classmates to read this book. This is due in on **Thursday 6th March.**
