Maths: Year 4 have been practising place value in numbers with up to four digits and have started looking at estimating number magnitude using number lines.

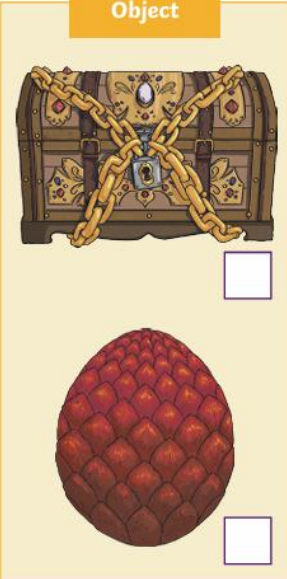
