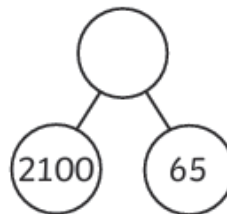
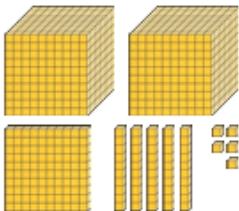

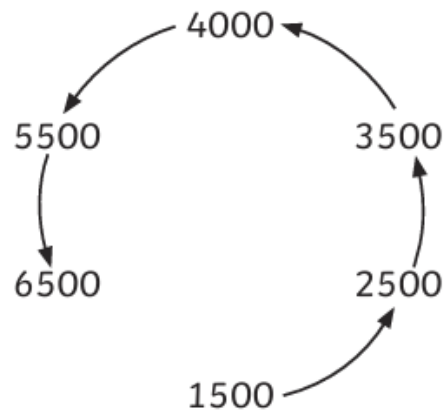


Tick the number indicated by the arrow on the number line.
